**GENERAL NOTES**

- Any discrepancy in totals is due to rounding.
- Until 2005, the reporting periods for Semesters 1 and 2 for student statistics ran from 1 September in the previous year to 31 August in the current year. This period changed in 2005 to cover the calendar year.
- Student enrolments data relate to the major programs and exclude concurrent minor programs.
- While student enrolments are measured in terms of persons, the student load is measured in terms of Equivalent Full-Time Student Load (EFTSL). A standard annual program is equivalent to 1 EFTSL.
- The staff numbers are measured in terms of Full-Time Equivalence (FTE). A full-time equivalence of 1 is the unit assigned to a member of staff working on a full-time basis for a full year.
- Where non-award data cannot be shown separately, they are incorporated in the undergraduate figures.

- NH&MRC - National Health and Medical Research Council
