# STATISTICAL SUMMARY 2008



## GENERAL NOTES

- Any discrepancy in totals is due to rounding.
- Where non-award data cannot be shown separately, they are incorporated in the undergraduate figures.
- Student numbers relate to the major programs and exclude concurrent minor programs in order to avoid double counting.
- The annual student count is not derived by adding the two half-year columns as this would result in double counting.
- Student load relates to the total load undertaken by a student and includes concurrent minor programs.
- The student load is measured in terms of Equivalent Full-Time Student Load (EFTSL). A standard annual program is equivalent to 1 EFTSL.
- The staff load is measured in terms of Full-Time Equivalence (FTE). A full-time equivalence of 1 is the unit assigned to a member of staff working on a full-time basis for a full year.
- Staff data are effective as at 31 March 2008. All other data are actual data for the year.

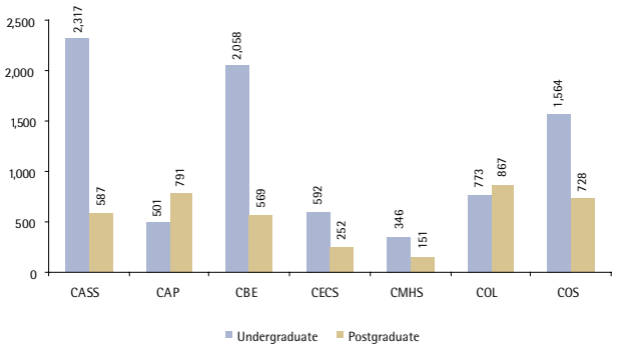

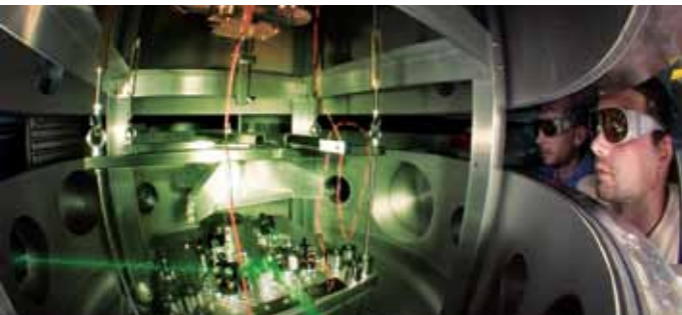

ANU is consistently placed among the best universities in the world by a whole range of international ranking systems. In 2008, the University was ranked first in Australia and 16th internationally by the *Times Higher Education Supplement*. That same year, in the Institute of Higher Education rankings released by the Shanghai Jiao Tong University, ANU was ranked above all of its Australian peers and 59th internationally. In the 2006 Newsweek International list of the Top 100 Global Universities, ANU was ranked 38th, the highest position of any Australian university. By a whole range of measures, it's clear that ANU is considered a leader in education and research.

Australia's only national university was established in 1946 by the Australian Government to lead the intellectual development of the nation through research and postgraduate study of the best international standards. The University began offering programs for undergraduate students in 1960. Today, ANU graduates are playing important roles in society such as politicians, business leaders, scientists, artists and policy advisors. ANU has international links with leading universities in the US, UK, Europe and Asia.
